Those are also the pictures of where they used to live when the Tsunami occurred.

That is also the pictures of my house been destroyed I was raised there when I was born and that is also the house where the church met when my dad obeyed the gospel 26 years ago.

My young brother who is living there with his family escaped to the bush and they were all survived. Other families of the church that are also living in the bush expressed their appreciation with tears from their eyes when they received foods and everything's we take.

They are living in tents without electricity and they are still in need of water and foods and clothes.

Our member here at Nu'uuli American Samoa 27 families are out from their jobs since the Tsunami hit the canneries and still don't know when they will be back to work.

FEMA and Red Cross are here but they only help the people and the villages that houses were destroyed by Tsunami.
