Shipment on Friday night (10/9/09)

More donations came pouring in and some of the monetary donations received was used to purchase more food in bulk to ship down. The total weight was 700 lbs and the shipping cost was \$245.00. Actual cost would've come close to \$1500 so we're thankful for the discount. We're also very thankful to Mr. Rick Ream and Ms. Jenni for transporting the goods to the cargo place late at night so we'd make it in time for the flight down to Samoa. This shipment, along with the boxes that went out on Thursday, arrived safely in American Samoa on Saturday evening. Some of the items were distributed to some of the families in need with children but the rest is en route to (Western) Samoa help with the brethren there who are now homeless. Thank you also to those who donated money. Spoke with my dad, some of it was used to buy kerosene for the families for their stoves to cook food and kerosene lamps since the power is still not stable. It's been 2 weeks since the tsunami and as the people are still cleaning and beginning to rebuild, a large percentage of the people are now getting sick from the dust, dengue fever, and a strong odor still looming in the air due to debris and animal carcasses (fish, chicken, etc). So next shipment will include some over the counter medicine - tylenol, cough syrup, mylanta (water not clean) etc. Please continue to keep them in your prayers and thank you all so much for everything! We praise God for you!
