

CAMP RULES

Ages 8–18 • Be kind • Be safe • Stay with your buddy

1) RESPECT + SAFETY

- Treat everyone with kindness and respect (no bullying or put-downs).
- Follow staff instructions right away (swim, hike, games, etc.).
- No rough play or running—especially near sleeping areas.
- Keep camp clean (trash in bins).
- Stay inside camp boundaries; don't wander off alone.

2) BUDDY + CURFEW + PHONES

- Buddy system: you must take your assigned buddy everywhere.
- If separated: tell an adult immediately and wait at the meeting spot.
- In your room by 10:00 PM; quiet hours start at 10:00 PM.
- No phones/electronics unless emergency or staff permission.
- Photos only if respectful and not invading privacy.

3) DRESS CODE (QUICK)

- Daytime: shirts with sleeves (no tank tops) + modest shorts/pants (not skin-tight).
- Bible study: no pajamas or swimsuits—wear clean, modest clothes.
- Swimming: rashguard/short-sleeve shirt + loose-fitting shorts required.
- Shoes: flip-flops allowed for showers/downtime; closed-toe shoes required for sports.
- Showers: be fully clothed to/from showers (no towel-only wraps).

4) CAMPFIRES + NATURE + SLEEP AREAS

- Campfire safety: fires must be watched at all times.
- Only adults supervise active fires; youth do not supervise.
- Stand an arm's length away from the fire ring.
- Leave no trace—respect nature and don't disturb wildlife.
- Keep your sleeping area clean; don't enter others' rooms/cabins.
